REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION

- 1. The prescribed Application Forms for U.G. and P.G. Courses can be had from the College Office.
- 2. Applicants selected for admission will have to be present for an interview with the Principal, with their parents, on the date and time mentioned in the phone message. They must bring:
- (a) Transfer Certificate
- (b) Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last studied.
- (c) Aadhaar Card Xerox copy
- (d) HSC Mark List for admission to Degree Courses and B.A.,/B.Sc.,/B.B.A./B.Com., Mark List for admission to PG Courses. Students are advised to take Xerox / Attested copies of the Original Certificates as they will not be returned to them before the completion of the Course under any circumstance.
- 3. The Applicant who fails to present himself at the Interview or who fails to pay the fees on the appointed day will forfeit his admission.
- 4. A recently taken Passport Size photo of the Applicant should be pasted in the space provided in the Application Form. Four Xerox copies of each Mark Statement and a Passport Size Photo must be submitted at the time of admission.
- 5. Admission will be made as per the Reservation Policy of the Govt. of Tamil Nadu for SC/ST/MBC/BC/, Physically Handicapped Students and sons of Freedom Fighters. Four seats are reserved for the sons of Ex-servicemen.
- 6. Apart from the fee-structure, each student has to pay the "Student Accident Benefit Scheme Premium" as follows, as per the Govt. Order.
