NSS REGULAR ACTIVITIES (2018-19)

Orientation programme for NSS volunteers

In the month of June, 2018 (29.06.2018), the four programme officers encouraged the new NSS volunteers to attract the various steps like, display of posters, leaflets, handbills, reflecting the aims and objectives in library, hostel, notice board and circular etc. A general meeting in the Auditorium was held to explain the Philosophy, aims and objectives of NSS and encourage new students to enroll themselves in the NSS. As many as 400 students took part in the programme and enrolled themselves in the college NSS units.

Compilation of NSS enrollment, constitution of NSS advisory committee, first meeting and preparation of the annual plan regularly as well as special camping activities and other community development programmes, preparation and submission of university annual plan by NSS officers.

Independence Day Celebration

On 15th of August, 2018 the Independence Day was celebrated jointly by the NSS and NCC Unit of the College. As many as Seventy five Saplings were planted inside the college campus by Alijanab Alhai S.Z. Abrar Ahmed Sahib, The Secretary and Correspondent, C. Abdul Hakeem College, Melvisharam. NSS SPECIAL CAMP FOR 2018 -19

A 7 day Special Camping Programme of our College NSS Units was conducted on the theme 'Clean India and Digital India'at Valaiyathur Village, Thimiri Block Arcot Taluk from 5.3.2019 to 11.3.2019 with a strength of 200 active NSS Volunteers. The inaugural function presided over by Alijanab Haji Sowcar Nisar Ahmed Saheb, Prisident, Melvisharam Muslim Educational Society. The Programme was inaugurated by our college Principal Dr. S.A. Sajid Ph, D., and the presence of the Village Administrative Officer Mr. V. Sobarajan, Regional Educational Officer J. Shanmuga Ananda Babu, Block Development Officer V. Sowarnalatha, Panchayat Secretary C. Balaji ,Village School Headmistress Mrs. K. Pourselvi and with the general public.

On the first day of the programme, the NSS Volunteers were divided into ten teams and each team headed by the senior volunteer. After that the Programme officers gave the lectures on the importance of the camp, rules and regulations were explained. They were oriented to cultivate a better relationship among themselves. Regular good habits were explained and they were practiced by the students like waking up early in the morning, doing meditation, prayer, yoga, physical exercises, reading Newspapers and reviewing the previous days' work as well as planning the day to day schedules etc.

The individual team leaders were assigned the works to be completed on the particular day. This had developed a team spirit and leadership qualities among the volunteers. On the second day in the evening Dr. D. Siva, Principal, Arcot Sri Mahalakshmi women College, Delivered a special lecture on the theme of Ambition. On the third day Dr. G. Gowtham, Former Principal, Govt College Of Education Vellore, gave a special talk on "The Role of Youths in the National Development". The fourth day Dr. S. Y. Anwer Shariff, Former Principal, C. Abdul Hakeem College, Melvisharam, delivered an inspiring address on "What Towards". On the fifth day Dr. H. Munarvarjan, NSS Programme Officer explained the theme of "Humanity". On the sixth day S. Athisayarooban, Red Ribbon Club, Vellore, interacted with our NSS volunteers on the topic "Celebrate the Life".

The NSS volunteers rendered remarkable service to the people of Valayathur and the surrounding villages namely Pallavarayankulam, M.G.R. Colony, Ambedkar Colony and Nangamangalam. They cleaned the various campuses of the temples like Sivan Temple, Murugan Temple etc, Churches and Mosque buildings, and kept the school playground neat and tidy. They cleaned the school campuses, public playground, Primary Health Centre, Co-oprative Store Premises, Public well, Public library, the roads and parks and by-lanes of the Valayathur village. The drainages were cleared off from blockages to eradicate the mosquito breeding centres. The local residents were educated to follow healthy hygienic practices. They were

apprised of the use of toilets and throwing up garbage only in dust bins. For the benefit of primary school children, our college had provided a HP Laser Printer.

A census on the educated youth unemployed as well as the school dropout children were conducted by our NSS volunteers during these camp days. The importance of maternal deliveries only in the Health Centres and Government Hospitals were explained to the people of the village.

The special camping programme was highlighted by conducting a special programme on 'AIDS Awareness', Tree Plantation, and the importance of health and hygiene were explained by the resource persons. To get the mind refreshed in their busy schedule, daily cultural activities were conducted in the evening hours along with the local public.

On the 7th day of the Camp the Valedictory Function was organized. It was presided over by Alijanab Alhaji S.Z. Abrar Ahmed Saheb, the Secretary and Correspondent. 




