Drug abuse and Illicit Trafficking

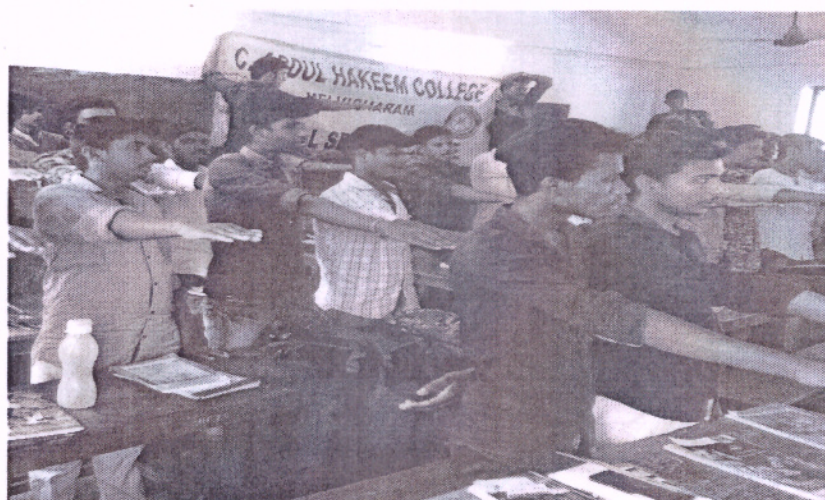

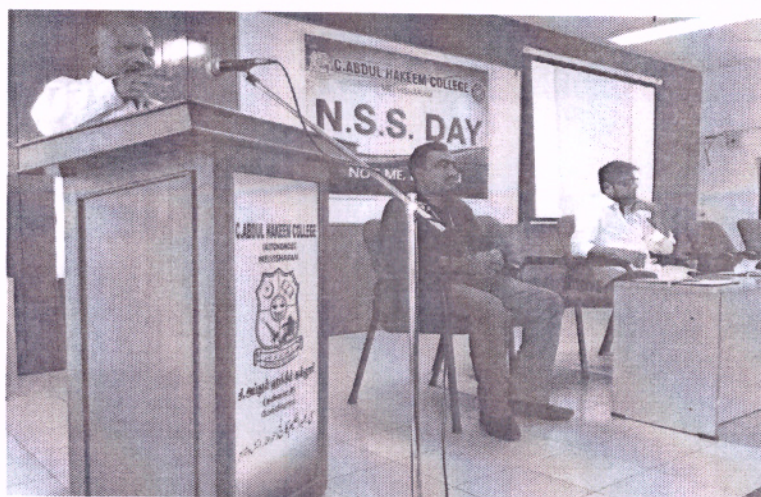

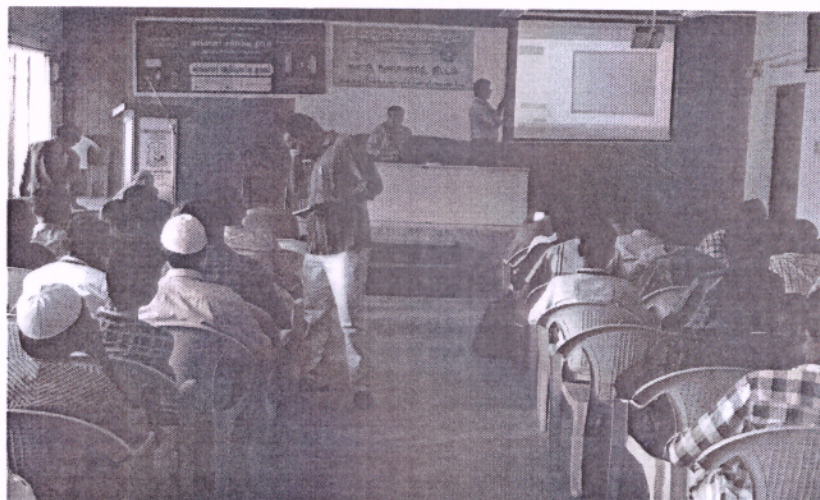
Electors Verification Programme (EVP)
