The Department had been sanctioned a sum of Rs.5,86,600/-by the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language, Ministry of HRD, Government of India, New Delhi, for promotion of Urdu Language among 200 Non-Urdu knowing Students, to help them to be eligible for the Diploma in Urdu Language, 200 Non-Arabic knowing and Less- Arabic knowing Students to qualify for the Certificate and the Diploma in Arabic Language and 100 Non-Persian knowing students to be eligible for the Certificate in Persian. As many as 80 Students had the credit of perusing the Certificate Course in Computer Application, Business Accounting and Multilingual DTP sponsored by the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language, Ministry of Education, Government of India, New Delhi in collaboration with the National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology [NIELIT]. This Academic Year, 520 students had registered for all the Ten Courses of NCPUL & NIELIT.
