

Urdu Majlis, NCPUL and NIELIT Study Centre

The Department had been sanctioned a sum of Rs.5,86,600/-by the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language, Ministry of HRD, Government of India, New Delhi, for promotion of Urdu Language among 200 Non-Urdu knowing Students, to help them to be eligible for the Diploma in Urdu Language, 200 Non-Arabic knowing and Less- Arabic knowing Students to qualify for the Certificate and the Diploma in Arabic Language and 100 Non-Persian knowing students to be eligible for the Certificate in Persian. As many as 80 Students had the credit of perusing the Certificate Course in Computer Application, Business Accounting and Multilingual DTP sponsored by the National Council for Promotion of Urdu Language, Ministry of Education, Government of India, New Delhi in collaboration with the National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology [NIELIT]. This Academic Year, 500 students had registered for all the Ten Courses of NCPUL & NIELIT.

The 18th Diploma Distribution Function was held on 06th February, 2025 and 488 Candidates received their Diplomas & Certificates. The Function was presided over by Alijanab S.Z. Abrar Ahmed, Secretary & Correspondent of the College. In his Special Address, the Chief Guest Dr.C.Dhandapani, Principal, K.M.G.Arts and Science College (Autonomous) Gudiyattam, brought to light the salient aspects of Urdu, Arabic & Persian Languages. He emphasized the fact that exchange of words with other languages is a natural part of how living Languages evolve. Dr. A. Md Anees, Consultant Physician Diabetologist, Fathima Clinic, Melvisharam, who was the Guest of Honour, presented a sparkling Special Address by citing examples of Tamil words used in day to day life.

Mohammed Tabrez, and others captivated the audience with their mimicry of renowned Urdu poets and diverse poetic styles. There was a range of topics with some poets alternating between the sublime and the mundane, describing their thoughts in a beautiful language, they kept the audience in raptures.

A State-Level Islamic Quiz Competition was held on October 10, 2024, with over 20 teams participating. Winners included students from B.S. Abdur Rahman University (1st Prize), The New College, Chennai (2nd Prize), and VIT University, Vellore (3rd Prize).

To celebrate International Mother Language Day on February 21, 2025, a special lecture on the "Importance of Mother Tongue" was conducted, featuring speakers Dr. L. Saritha and Janab Moulana Syed Mohiuddeen Hussaini Oomeri.

In the above said competitions more than 300 students took part to prove their mettle.

In the Two days National Level Seminar,entitled "Kalanthorum Tamil," which featured keynote speaker Dr. N. Sivaguru from Thiruvalluvar University, and

valedictorian speaker Dr.P.Rajesh from Tamil University, Thanjore , had around 120 participants.42 of them presented papers and received certificates and accolades.

These events provided platforms for students and scholars to share their knowledge and talents, and also brought in well known Tamil scholars.

International Mother Language Day Observance

In observance of International Mother Language Day, the Language Departments convened a Special Lecture on the "Importance of Mother Tongue" on February 21st, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. The function was presided over by our respected Principal, Dr. S.A. Sajid. The keynote address was delivered by Dr. L. Saritha, Assistant Professor in the Department of English at M.M.E.S. Women's Arts and Science College, Melvisharam. A compelling special lecture was also presented by Janab Moulana Syed Mohiuddeen Hussaini Oomeri, Urdu Munshi at Islamiyah Boys Higher Secondary School, Melvisharam. This significant program was organized by the Language Departments, convened by Dr. M. Thamim Mansoor, Head of the Department of Tamil, directed by Dr. S. Mohamed Yassir, Head of the Department of Urdu, and coordinated by Mr. K. Abdul Munaf, Head of the Department of English, alongside the collaborative efforts of the departmental faculties.

English Association

The Department of English enjoyed a remarkably productive academic year, distinguished by notable scholastic achievements, impactful research contributions, vibrant student engagement, and a plethora of enriching extracurricular activities.
